What did we do?

1. Member Survey

(all Full Members invited to participate)

2. Education Survey

(all educational institutions who are Affiliate Members invited to participate)

Member Survey

- All 38 EFRS Member Societies were invited to complete this survey in January 2017.
- Responses were received from 32 of the EFRS Member Societies representing a response rate of 84.2% (also n=32 for 2015 survey / 94.3%).

Education Survey

- All 51 Educational Institutions who were EFRS Affiliate Members were invited to complete this survey in January 2017.
- Responses were received from 45 Educational Institutions representing a response rate of 88.2% (n=41 / 89.1% for 2015 survey).

Combined responses from Member and Education surveys

National labour market

- Disagreement between National Societies and Educational Institutions on jobs available to graduates in Radiotherapy and Nuclear Medicine:

Radiotherapy	National Societies	Educational Institutions
Not enough jobs	92.86%	69.23%

Nuclear Medicine	National Societies	Educational Institutions
Enough jobs	70.83%	48.65%

Radiography journal

Would you be interested in gaining access to the Radiography journal for the whole of your membership/staff students?

- Yes = 92.94%

Respondents from Educational Institutions were slightly more likely to be interested in gaining access to the Radiography journal than the Societies, with 97.96 % and 86.11% respectively.

EFRS Publications

- *EQF Level 6 (Bachelors) Benchmarking Document for Radiographers (2014)* and the *EQF Level 7 (Masters) Benchmarking Document for Radiographers (2016)* identified as the ‘most valuable’ EFRS publications by National Societies and Educational Institutions alike!
- Followed by:
 - *Statement on Radiographer Role Development (2012)* and *Code of Ethics (2010)* by National Societies.
 - *Statement on Radiographer Education in Europe (2012)* and *Statement on CPD (2013)* by Educational Institutions.

Public or patient involvement in your society/programme

- Yes = 26.19%
- No = 76.19%
- *Educational Institutions are more likely to involve public or patients in their work than Societies with 34.69% and 14.29% respectively.*

Member Survey

Graduates of combined programmes

Do graduates of combined programmes have the opportunity of being employed in a combined role, i.e. working in both MI and RT or NM and RT, or must they choose one area?

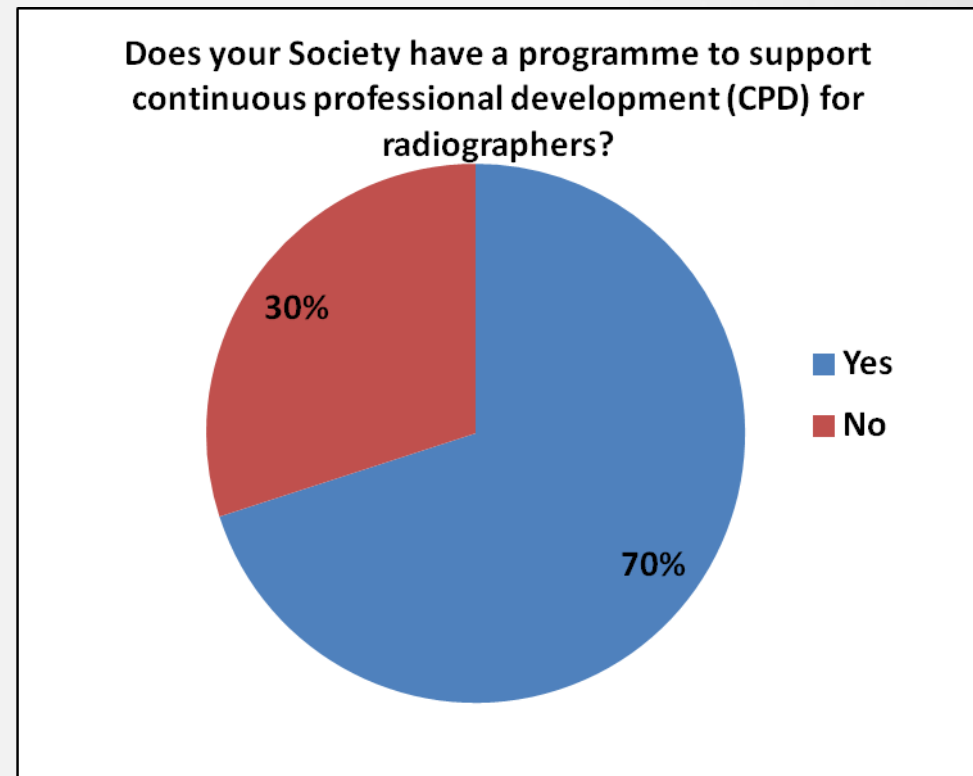
- Responses were received from 30 out of 38 respondents
- 60% (n=18) - a combined role was possible
- 40% (n=12) - graduates must choose one area

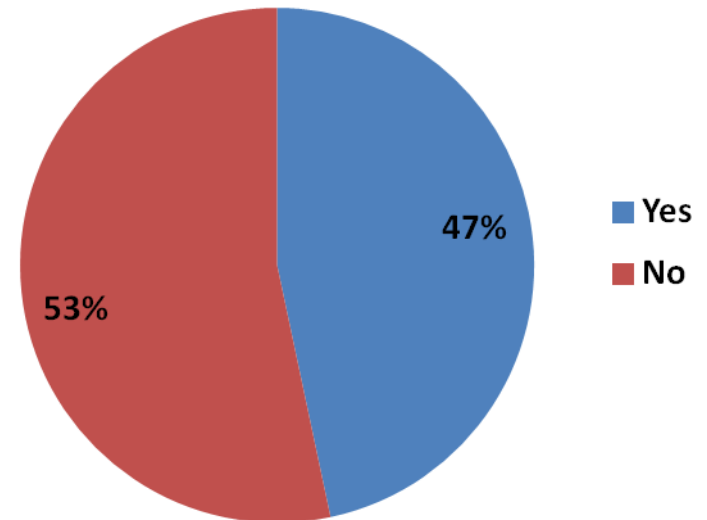
Is CPD mandatory in your country?

Is CPD obligatory for radiographers to exercise the profession in your country?

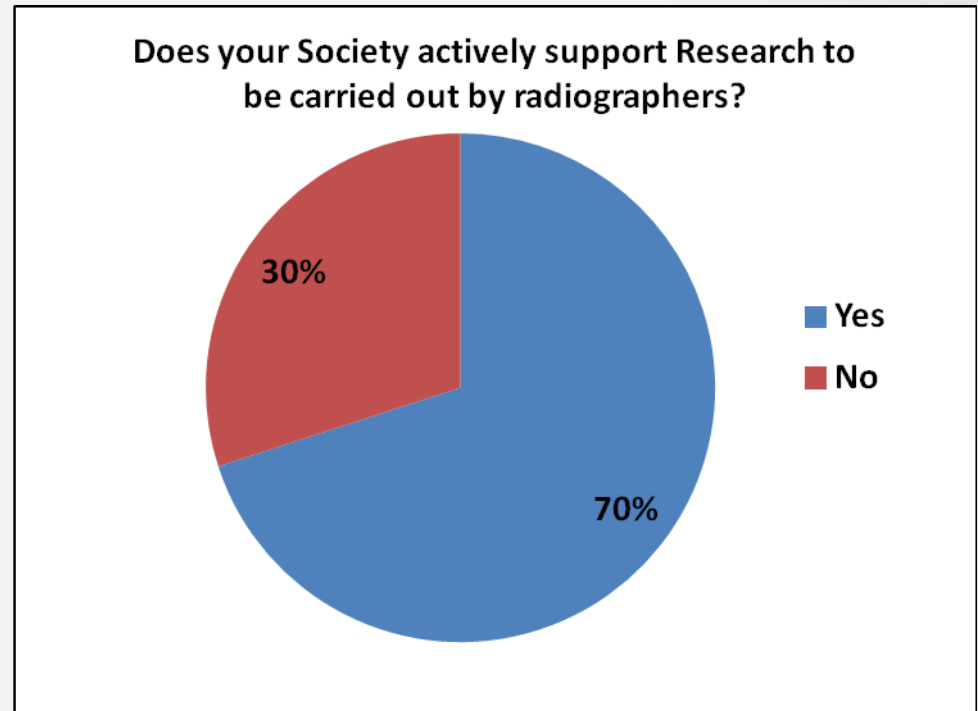


Does your Society actively support radiographer research?

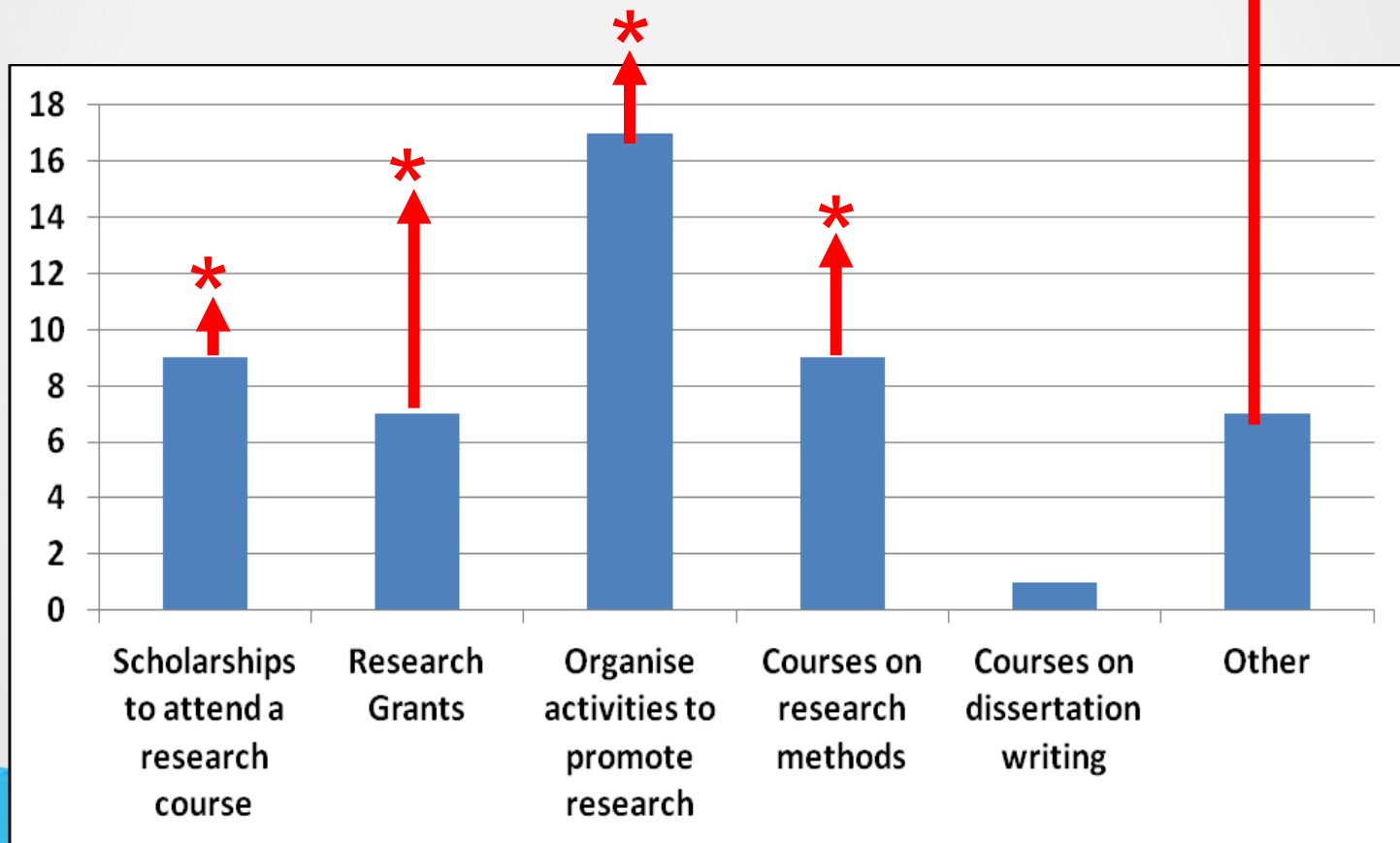
- Yes = 75%

2017 shown by *

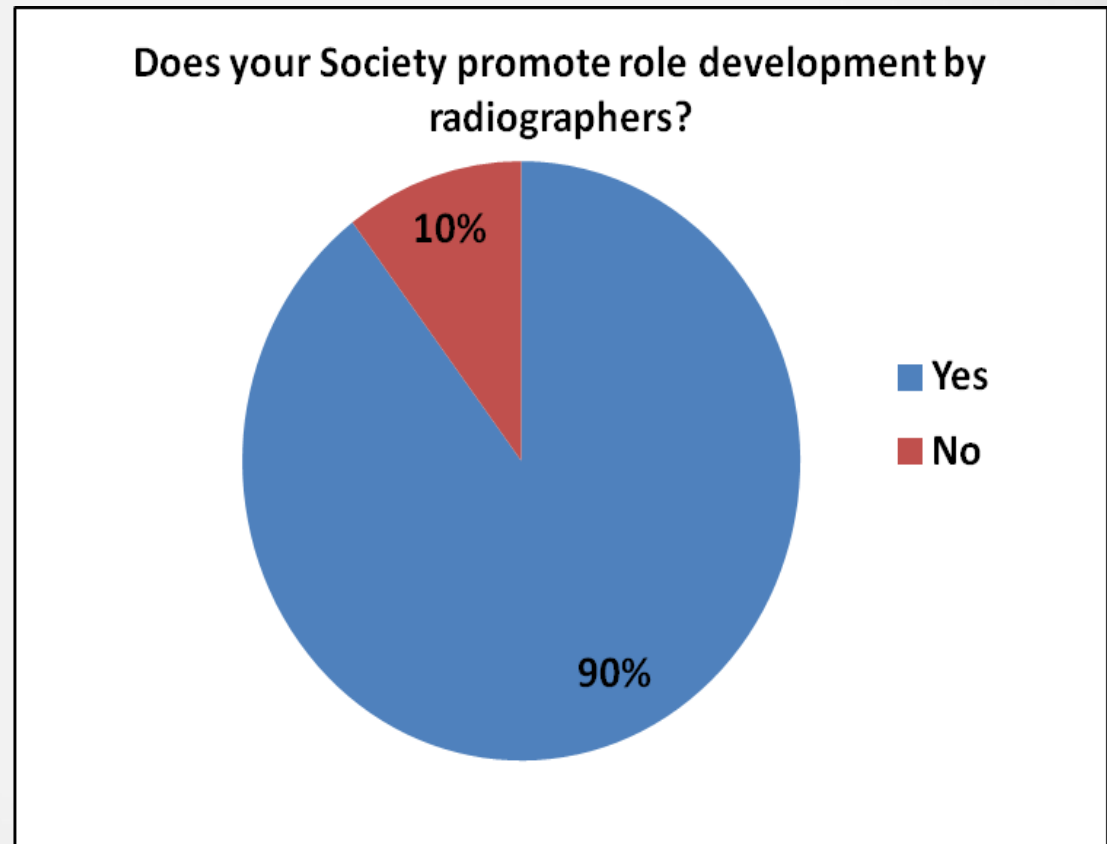


Does your Society Promote Role Development?
